SECTION 2 — HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Hazard class: Self-heating substances and mixtures (Category 2). Self-heating in large quantities; may catch fire (H252). Keep cool, protect from sunlight (P235+P410).

SECTION 4 — FIRST AID MEASURES
